



### ABSTRACT

Medical Education - Admission of Students under NRI Quota in Self Financing Colleges from the academic year 2009-10 - Guidelines - Orders - Issued.

### ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above orders were issued prescribing guidelines for admission to MBBS Course under NRI quota during the year 2006-07. As per the orders of the Supreme Court of India dated 3.11.08, the Government order second read above have issued guidelines to be adopted for admission of students under NRI quota in Self Financing Engineering Colleges and Self Supporting Courses run in Government Aided Engineering Colleges from the academic year 2009-2010.

2. As per the guidelines issued in the Government order second read above, the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee has sent proposal for the eligibility criteria and guidelines for the admission under NRI Scheme in the MBBS / BDS Courses irrespective of the status conferred to the institutions as Minority / Non-Minority as detailed below:-

1. Candidates should be of Indian Origin settled in Foreign countries.  
OR  
Candidates who were born in foreign countries and whose parents are of Indian Origin.  
OR  
Children of Indian citizen stay abroad for employment, business  
OR  
Children of Indian citizens deputed abroad by Public Sector Undertaking  
OR

Children of the Official of the Central / State Government on deputation to abroad.

2. The candidates seeking admission to NRI Quota should have hold Indian passport.
3. The candidate should have completed 17 years on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission.
4. Candidates seeking admission to MBBS /BDS course under NRI Quota should have passed H.Sc., Examination (10+2 pattern / equivalent)
5. The candidate should have obtained the minimum of 50% marks in Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together and the minimum of 50% marks each in Physics and Chemistry.
6. The medium of instruction should be English
7. Admission under Non Resident of India scheme may be made on the basis of the marks obtained in the Qualifying Examination as prescribed in clause 4 & 5 above.
8. The duration of the course will be 5 ½ years including one year CRRi for MBBS and incase of BDS duration of the course will be 5 years.
9. In cases where two or more candidates obtained equal marks rank of such candidate may be determined on the basis of the seniority in age.
10. The seats under NRI quota should be utilized by the bonafide NRI's only and for their children or wards. Therefore, the NRI financially supporting the candidates should either be the parent (Father or Mother) of the candidate or legally declared as guardian of the candidate by the Court as per provisions in "The Guardians and Wards Act 1890".
11. Candidates admitted under "NRI" quota should submit the following documents.
  - 1) NRI status of the financial supporter issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective country under their seal.



ii) Certificate of Relationship between the NRI financial supporter and the candidate issued by the competent authority, valid Indian Passport of the NRI financial supporter.

iii) NRE(Non Resident External) Bank Account Pass Book of the financial supporter.

iv) Evidence for payment of Development charges US \$ 1000/- to the college by the NRI financial supporter (One time payment at the time of admission only)

12. The candidates should furnish equivalent marks for the grades awarded at the qualifying examination. If not, the minimum marks will be taken to consideration.

13. No NRI sponsored candidates are allowed under NRI scheme.

14. Institutions are not permitted to charge equivalent amount of NRI fees from the students admitted under vacant NRI seats.

15. The fee chargeable from the students against the vacant shall be the same as fixed by the Fee Fixation Committee constituted for this purpose.

16. NRI seats allotted under NRI scheme shall not exceed 15% of the total sanctioned strength and this should be within the ratio of apportionment of seats fixed by the Government from time to time.

3. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee for admission under NRI Scheme in the MBBS/ BDS courses and issue the following orders:-

(i) the eligibility criteria / guidelines suggested by Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee as in para 2 above for admission of candidates for MBBS / BDS course under NRI Scheme in Self-Financing Medical / Dental colleges from the year 2009-10 irrespective of the status conferred to the institutions as Minority / Non-Minority be accepted;

(ii) the concession of minimum 40% of marks given to the SC/ST Students in the Government order first read above shall be retained;

(iii) the above guidelines ordered for NRI Quota shall also apply to the Para Medical Courses run by Self-Financing Institutions.

4. The Director of Medical Education / Additional Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary action accordingly.
