2. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Dean, Annapoorana Medical College and Hospital, Salem based on the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education for conferring of Telugu Linguistic Minority status for 5 years from 2017-2018 to 2021-2022.

Accordingly the Government do and hereby direct that the renewal of conferment of Telugu Linguistic Minority Status be granted to Annapoorana Medical College and Hospital, Salem run by the Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation Trust, Salem for a period of five years from the academic year 2017-2018 on the basis of Telugu Linguistic Minority for admission of students in the Annapoorana Medical College and Hospital, Salem, subject to the ultimate guidelines that are to be laid down by the Regular Bench of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India based on "Indicia" for treating an educational institution as a minority institution and subject to the conditions stipulated in the Government Orders first and second read above.
